Participating classes:

85cc – rider's age must be 10-15 (including the year when the age of 10 or 15 is reached)

Junior 125 – rider's age must be 13-18 (including the year when the age of 13 or 18 is reached)

MX1 - rider's age must be at least 14 (including the year when the age of 14 is reached)

MX2 - rider's age must be at least 14 (including the year when the age of 14 is reached)

Women - rider's age must be at least 13 (including the year when the age of 13 is reached)

Registration:

Riders must register to their national FMN with information about their name, birthday, national license number and license type, transponder number, national start number and which class they wish to participate in. Each FMN must then send their list of participants to lkh@dmusport.dk no later than June the 10th, together with a starting permission for all of them.

Registration fee:

The registration fee will be 400 DK kroner (53,70 euros). This amount must be collected by the rider's national FMN and transferred to the DMU.

Starting numbers

Riders must register to their own FMN with their national start number. In case of coinciding start numbers, the organizer will deal with that at the time of arrival.

Transponders

Rider must bring their own transponder.

Race office: Friday the 22nd from 7 pm – 8:30 pm and Saturday the 23rd from 7 am - 8 am.

Race office closes: Saturday the 23rd at 8 am.

Race office location: Rundbuehallen (the barn close to the washing area).

Instruction: 8:05 am.

Technical Control: 8:20 am.

Training/time qualification and heats according to the provisional timetable, which includes 1 training/time qualification and 3 heats for all classes.

Prize giving according to the provisional timetable and with prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in all classes.

Environmental regulations:

Washing of the machines must only take place in the washing area, no chemicals allowed.

Environmental mats must be used.

Club information:

Electricity can be purchased.

Smoking according to instructions at the venue. Open fire is prohibited.

Dogs must be on leash.

No driving on MX and Pitbikes since the paddock includes a public road.

Food and drinks can be purchased in the cafeteria.

From 10 pm until 7 am, the paddock must be calm and quiet.

Additional information:

Together with the Nordic Championship, the club is hosting a trophy cup for the classes C65, B65, C85, C125, C MX2, C MX1 and Old Boys 30+A/B/C. Foreign riders are very welcome to participate in these classes, so this is an opportunity also for the foreign riders to make it a family or club event where everyone can be a part of the event.
